With a Selection Index score of 201 or above, each of these students is among

the 50,000 highest-scoring participants of some 1.5 million-program entrants.

The National Merit Scholarship Corporation, a nonprofit organization that operates without government assistance, was established in 1955 specifically to conduct the National Merit Program. Scholarships are underwritten by NMSC with its own funds and by approximately 500 business organizations and higher education organizations that share NMSC's vision. NMSC's goal is to honor the nation's scholastic champions and encourage the pursuit of academic excellence.
